



## **Team Leader Maintenance Technician**

Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, responsible and accountable for all maintenance, facilities and utilities operations. Directs and coordinates activities of associates engaged in repair, maintenance, and installation of machines, tools, and equipment processes, and in maintenance of buildings, grounds, and utility systems in compliance with all OSHA, EPA, and USDA standards.

### **Responsibilities to include but not limited to:**

- Communicate closely with Maintenance Technicians and other team members on the status of work progress.
- Perform maintenance duties to troubleshoot and repair defective equipment in timely manner. Performs predictive and preventive maintenance duties and generate work requests to repair defective equipment.
- Responds to assigned work orders and input to Maintenance Management System.
- Assist in the education of other team members to produce a multifunctional maintenance department.
- Develop proper courses of action, act quickly with good judgment and attention to detail.
- Respond to facility Engineering and maintenance matters after hours, as needed.
- Responsible for maintaining accurate material and labor costs, produce maintenance reports, effectively analyze situations.
- Performs other duties as necessary.
- Carries out supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws.

### **Education/Training:**

- Related education, participation in a trade or apprenticeship program and/ or training may be considered.
- Experience in a chilled food manufacturing environment preferred.
- Knowledge and experience with Food Manufacturing (Kill floor and processing) equipment and USDA standards is highly desirable.

### **Knowledge/Skills/Abilities:**

- Demonstrate knowledge with HazMat, MSDS, ADA, NFPA, OSHA and other regulations.
- Ability to read blueprints and/ or schematics.
- Ability to resolve related problems, exercising good technical judgment and precedent matters.
- Ability to identify trends and/or problem areas. Implement corrective actions.
- Able to work in a chilled environment and stand for extended periods. Repetitive lifting, reaching, pushing required

- Must be able to respond to facility matters after hours when needed.
